The following airlines operate into Launceston Airport which is just 15 kilometres south of the CBD: *Virgin Blue, Jetstar, Qantas and Tiger Airways.*

There are flights from Tullamarine (Melbourne) and direct flights from Sydney and Brisbane.

## **Accommodation**

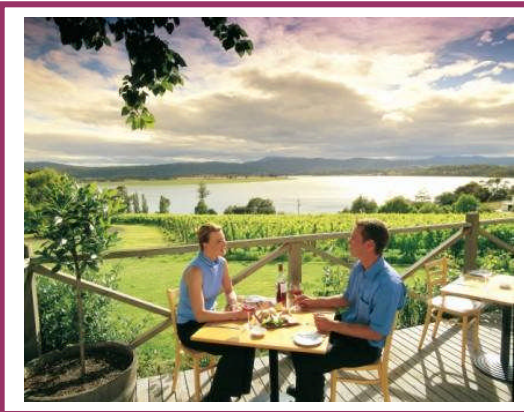
Accommodation options are available on the AIR website. We have a great range and prices all within walking distance of the conference venue, the Hotel Grand Chancellor.
